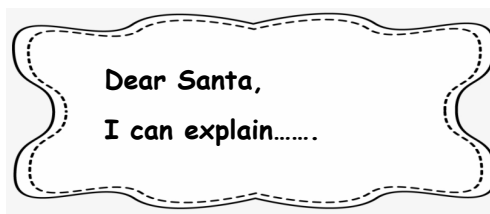

## **This & That...**

- The library will be closed December 24th, 25th and 26th. We will close at 5:30 p.m. on December 31st and be closed New Years Day. That doesn't mean you can't enjoy free books, audiobooks, magazines and movies. Visit the library early and stock up OR use the Libby app to access READS. Use your library card to download items to enjoy on your electronic device or computer. Ask a staff member for details.
- If you have a child under the age of 5 who is not registered for the Imagination Library, stop in and fill out an application. Your child will receive a book in the mail each month until his/her fifth birthday. The program is open to all children in Lawrence County and is free.
- Have you visited the Tennessee Electronic Library lately? If not, you may be missing valuable information. You will find resources for searching family histories, test preparation, homework assistance and many other databases and journals.
